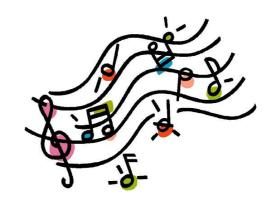

Ukulele Skills

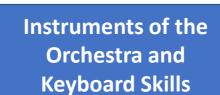

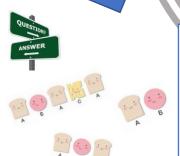




Elements of Music
