Change in Curriculum Model from September 2017

We are constantly evaluating our curriculum to ensure that it provides the best possible opportunities for all students to maximise their potential. As a result of this process, I can now inform you of an important change to the curriculum model at The Telford Langley School. Extensive changes to KS4 courses have come about due to new government directives and the increased subject content expected for the new terminal qualifications. It is sensible therefore, for pupils to choose the subjects that they wish to continue with in Year 8 rather than Year 9. This will ensure that they then have three years to fully prepare for all assessments.

We are therefore introducing Subject Pathway choices during Year 8 so that the new curriculum model will be in place from September 2017.

To facilitate the transition to a 3 year KS4, pupils in both Year 8 and Year 9 will be selecting their Subject Pathway choices this year. In subsequent years the Pathways process will focus on Year 8 pupils only.

Further information will be sent out after the February half term explaining the subjects that are available. You will also receive a Pathways form for your child to select their choices. Additionally, there will be a Pathways Evening where you can speak to class teachers and senior staff about the subject choices available for your child.
