A. Texture

A single melodic line. MONOPHONIC A chordal style or melody and accompaniment: moving together. **HOMOPHONIC** A more complex (contrapuntal) texture with a number of different lines. **POLYPHONIC** A tune with Melody and accompaniment (e.g. accompaniment chords). All parts play/sing the same music at the same Unison time. The music moves in Chordal chords (e.g. like a hymn/ chorale). A decorative, higher Descant pitched line. A new melody, combined Countermelody with the theme. Round A short (vocal) canon. The melody is repeated exactly in different Canon parts but starting at different times, with parts overlapping. Long held notes. Drone Textures which have 2/3/4 2-3-4 part different lines. texture

B. Jazz and Blues

/nonsense syllables.
Improvised: music made up on the spot.
Blue notes: flattened 3rd, 5ths and 7ths.
Syncopation: off-beat accents.

Call and Response: a phrase played/sung by a leader and repeated by others.
Walking bass: bass line that 'walks up' and down the notes of a scale/arpeggio.
Swing style: 'jazzy' rhythm with a

accents of speech.

Overture: an orchestral introduction to the show, which usually uses tunes from the show.

The orchestra /band is used to accompany the voices and underscore.
